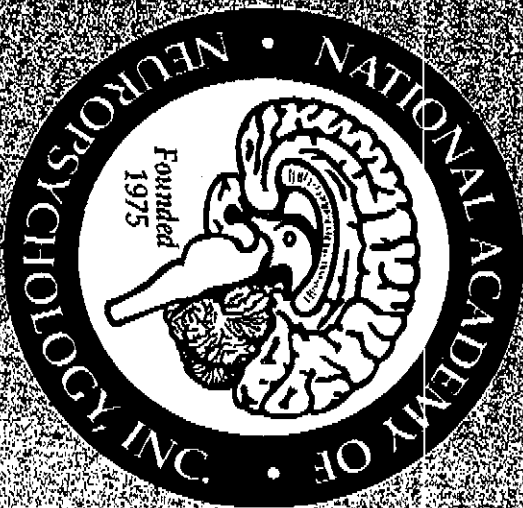

## Current Procedural Terminology, 1998 Update

The 1998 version of the American Medical Association Current Procedural Terminology (CPT) has changed considerably from the 1997 version. The major differences are found (though not exclusively) with the psychotherapy codes. The following provides a general overview of the major CPT codes applicable to neuropsychology and reimbursable by most third parties. 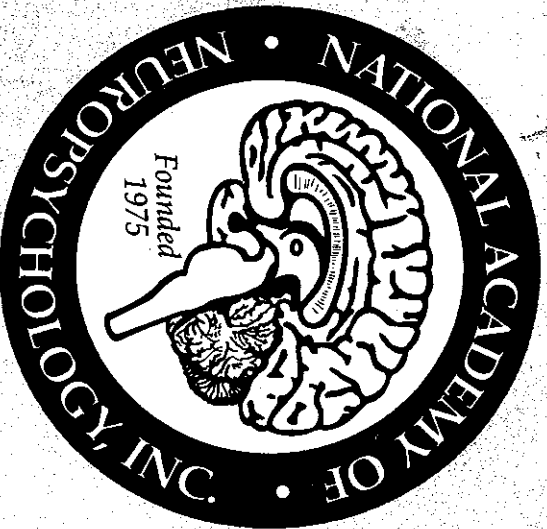
