L. Philip Guzman (APA Office of Ethnic Minority Affairs) -- will discuss APA's efforts in the training of ethnic minority students.


Antonio Puenté (University of North Carolina at Wilmington) -- will conclude the formal presentations as the discussant.

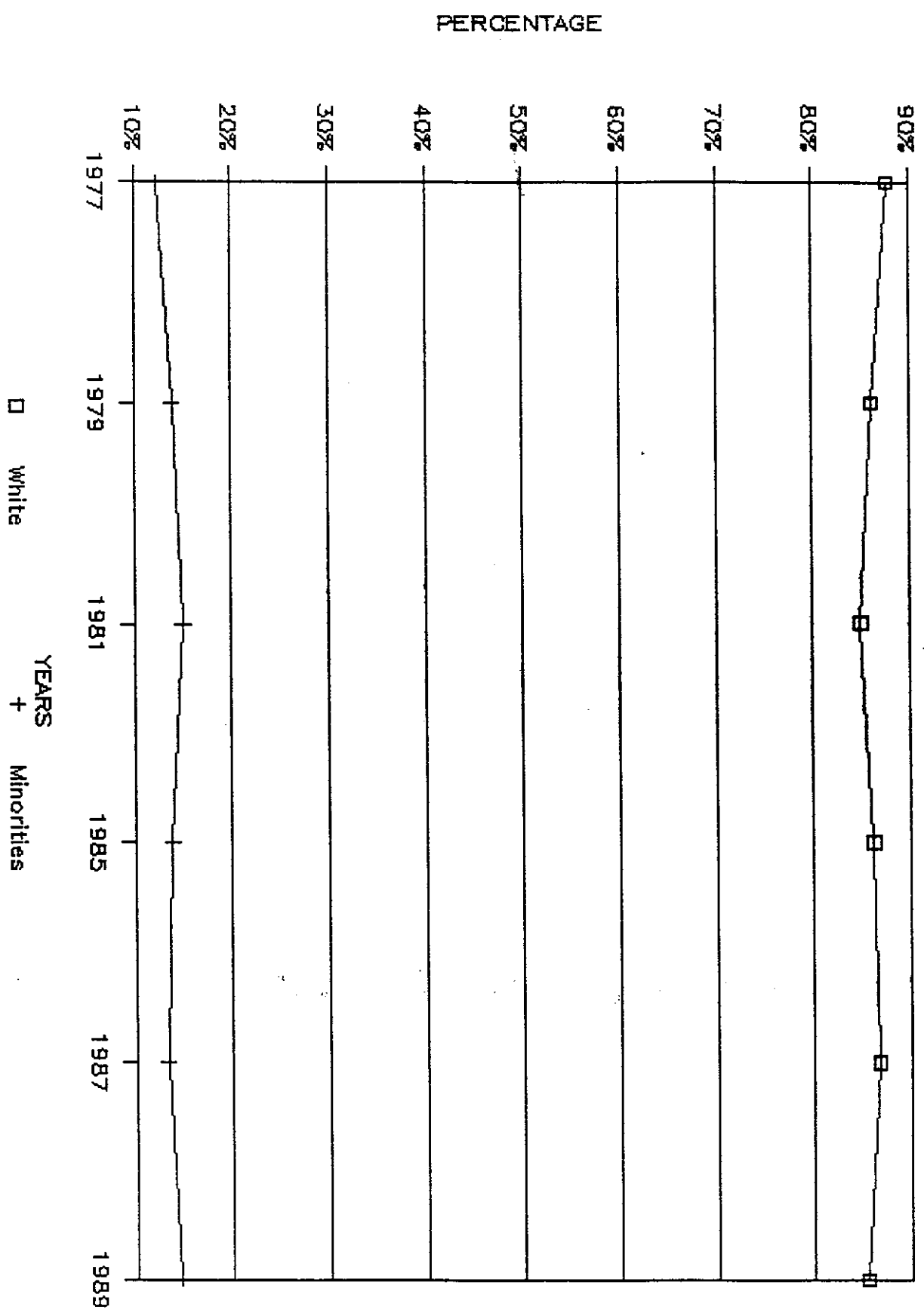

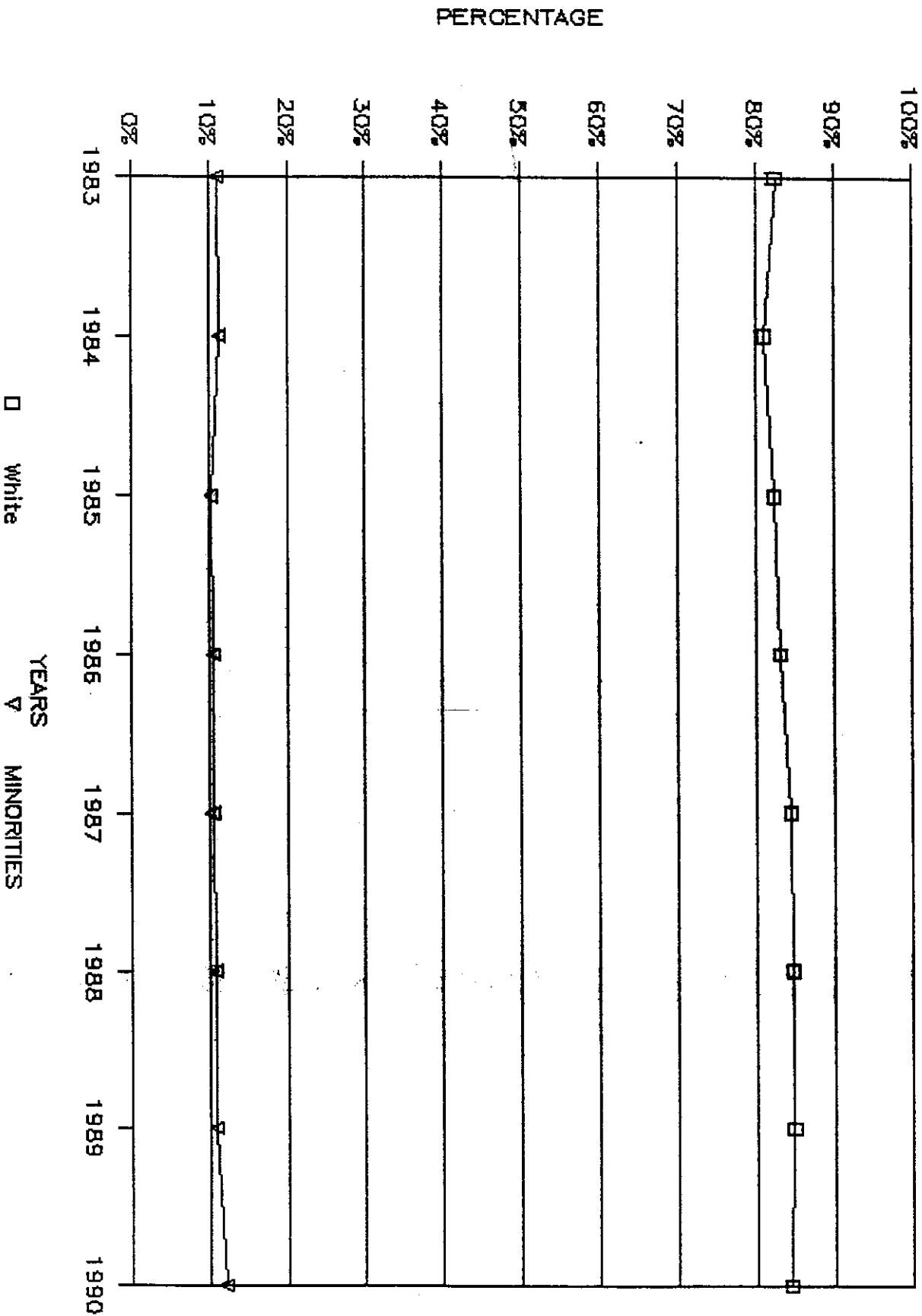
# BA DEGREE BY ETHNICITY

1977-1989



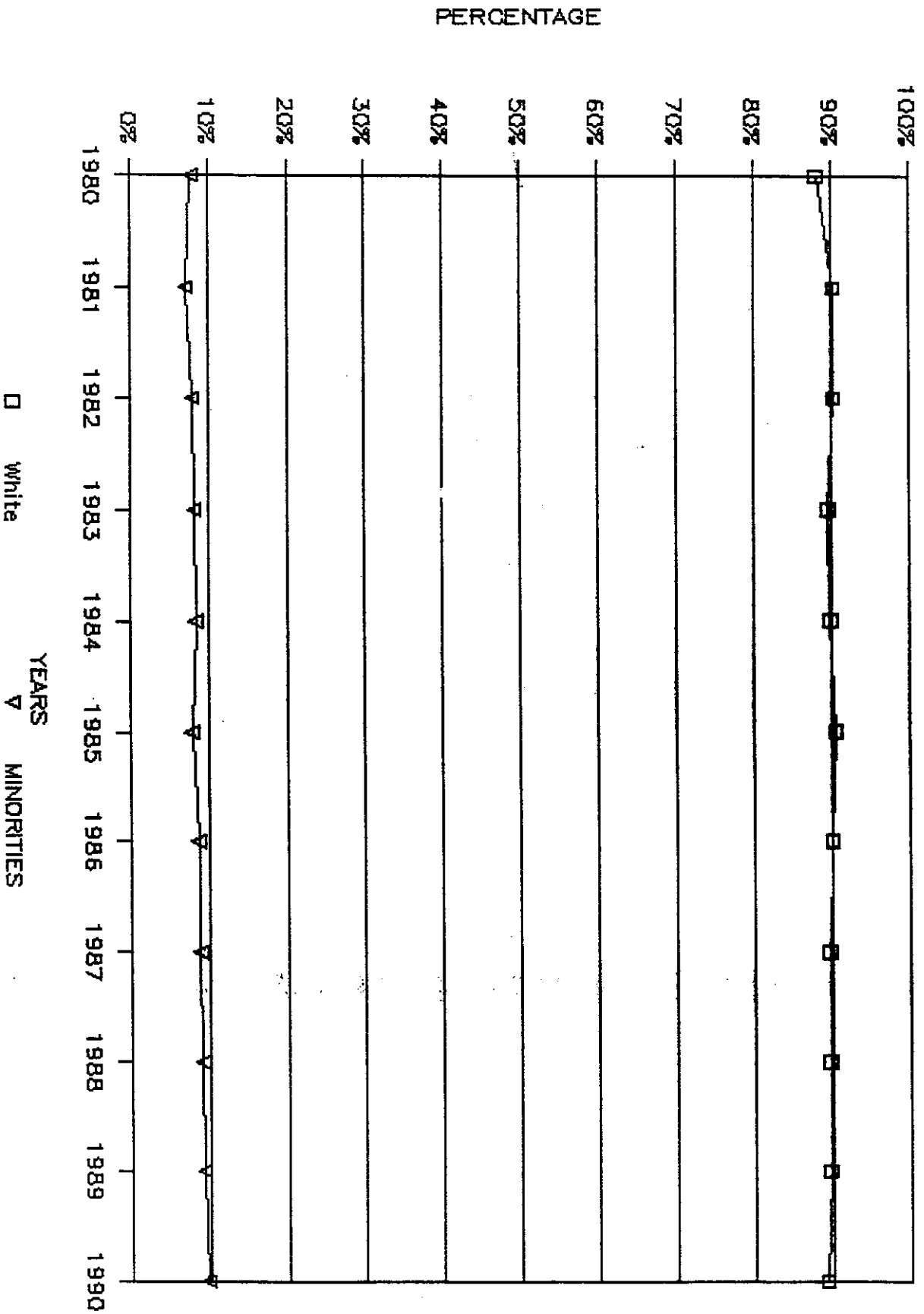
# GRADUATE STUDENTS BY ETHNICITY
