Advocacy

- Shapes health care in America by participating in the AMA CPT process (25 years) & the Medicare Coverage Advisory Committee (5 years). The CPT system essentially decides which healthcare procedures are done & how much can be reimbursed.
- Founded mental health service at Cape Fear Clinic 15 years ago and was president of the board (5 years). The mental health clinic is integrated with other health care services and is primarily staffed by students.



Platform

- **Advocacy, leadership and results in the practice, science, teaching and public service of psychology.**

Leadership

- President of 5 organizations including National Academy of Neuropsychology (NAN) and Division 40 of APA.
- Chair of 6 APA Boards and Committees including Committee for Undergraduate Education and Continuing Education member of another 10 (over 30 years).
