While serving as Interim Chief Executive Officer and Executive Vice President of the American Psychology Association (APA), Dr. Cynthia Belar conducted a listening tour and established regular communication with APA employees; hired a new General Counsel; re-structured Membership, Governance, Communications, and the Executive offices.

Dr. Belar conducted an extensive review of the 2017 budget and recommended adjustments necessary to get on a path to a balanced integrated budget; the balancing of our C3 and C6 missions were always at the forefront of discussions.
